9. NO BY-CYCLES, GO-CARTS , MOTORIZED ,OR ANY SIMILAR TYPE VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE PARK. HOWEVER; BY-CYCLES MAY BE IN DESIGNATED BY-CYCLE RACKS OR THE RACK AREA. [THE ONLY OTHER ACCEPTION TO THIS WILL BE ADA MANUAL OR MOTORIZED EQUIPMENT]
10. ANYONE VIOLATING ANY OF THESE BY-LAWS WILL BE SUBJECT TO A FINE AS A MUNICIPAL INFRACTION OF \$50.00 OR SUSPENSION FROM THE USE OF THE PARK FOR THIRTY (30) DAYS TO ONE (1) YEAR OR BOTH.
11. ANYONE CAUGHT ABUSING OR MISUSING ANY OF THE EQUIPMENT SHALL BE SUBJECT THE DISCIPLINARY ACTION INDICATED IN #10 ABOVE. THE EQUIPMENT PURCHASED IS MARKED FOR AGE GROUPS TO USE.

SECTION 3-802: PENALTIES

AS INDICATED ABOVE IN #10 AND 11.

It is the intention of the Mayor and Council and it is hereby ordained, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances and;







ORDINANCE NO: 2016-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GALENA TO REVISE THE RENTAL RATES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE TOWN PICNIC PAVILIONS AND FACILITIES

WHEREAS, Section 502 (44) of the Charter of the Town of Galena authorizes the Town Council to maintain public parks and recreational facilities;

WHEREAS, the Town owns and maintains a public park that contains pavilions and facilities, the rules and regulations of such are contained in Chapter 123 of the Code of the Town of Galena; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Town for the Town to revise the rules and regulations with respect to the rental of the park pavilions and facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF GALENA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 123-1 C. of the Code of Galena is hereby amended to read as follows:

“§ 123-1. Rules and Regulations

- C. The cost to rent picnic pavilions/facilities for a day shall be set by the Town Council from time to time by Resolution. After the park has been inspected by the Public Works Supervisor or other Town Employee, Agent, or Official, and has been determined to be in satisfactory condition, 50% of the rental fee will be**

returned to the renter, and 50% of the rental fee will be retained by the Town for administration, maintenance, and upkeep of the park and equipment therein. If the park is not in a satisfactory condition, 100% of the rental fee shall be retained by the Town.”


SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court or competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance, it being the intent of the Mayor and Council that this Ordinance shall stand, notwithstanding the invalidity of any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion thereof.


SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. The title of this Ordinance, or a condensed version thereof, shall be deemed to be, and is, a fair summary of this Ordinance for publication and all other purposes.

This Ordinance, having been introduced on August 1, 2016 and adopted on September 6, 2016, we hereby affix our signatures. Effective September 27, 2016. A summary of this Ordinance shall be published twice in a newspaper having general circulation within the Town of Galena.






TOWN PARK PAVILION RENTAL RATE SCHEDULE


Town Resident: \$100 per day


Non Profit Organization based in the greater Galena or Kent County Area: Two Free Daily Rentals per year; \$50 per day for all additional rentals

All others: \$150 per day




